Purpose and Objective

PURPOSE

- Provide county representatives with RFP guide for municipalities who are interested in electronic waste (E-Waste) and household hazardous waste (HHW) service programs in conjunction with residential waste and recycling programs



OBJECTIVE

- Reduce burden of time, labor and cost to Illinois Counties as municipalities including E-Waste and HHW programs reduce needs for county wide programs



Trend and Issues

TREND -

- Municipalities are often requesting E-Waste and HHW service options in conjunction with residential waste programs
- Though not every waste service provider offers these options, some do.
- Program structures vary.

ISSUES - Municipal staff representatives drafting RFP's are often;

- Unaware of available E-Waste/HHW programs
- Have limited knowledge on E-Waste/HHW services
- Have limited knowledge on requesting necessary provisions
- Reluctant to include due to perceived cost(s) or cost increase and lack of knowledge



Assistance



Encourage municipal representatives to include E-Waste and HHW service options in conjunction with RFP's for residential waste service programs.

This should reduce associated burdens for the local county.

The **RFP Guide to E-Waste and HHW** may be used as a tool for municipal staff who are not well versed or familiar with either programs.
